Course Description

The ArchestrA Workflow 2012 Overview course is a 3-day, instructor-led class designed to provide a basic understanding of the software as an extension to Business Process Management (BPM) strategies to create end-to-end manufacturing scenarios spanning across systems and human workforces.

The class provides lectures and hands-on labs to illustrate the configuration, definition, execution, and analysis of workflows using the System Platform Extension and Connector for integration with Application Server.

- Use the System Platform Connector for ArchestrA Workflow
- Configure the \$WorkflowGateway object within a Galaxy for communication with the ArchestrA Workflow services
- Configure workflow events to trigger workflows from within the Galaxy
- Configure and execute workflows using a set of primary activities
- Design and deploy forms to use within workflows
- Configure and reports on Key Performance Indicators (KPI) around the execution of workflows
