GR or remote platform deployment to a system running Windows 10, version 1803 may cause a kernel mode crash or blue screen

SUMMARY

The issue is known to effect System Platform versions:

- 2014 R2 SP1 Patch 02
- 2017 Update 2

SITUATION

Deployment of a platform (GR or remote) to a system running Micorosoft's recently released **Windows 10**, **version 1803** may cause a kernel mode crash or blue screen on the target deployment node.

SYMPTOMS

- The platform deployment has finished the file transfer phase.
- The kernel crash happens in the runtime environment setup phase on the target deployment platform, either GR or remote node.

ACTION

Implement one of the following workarounds:

- Workaround 1 Do not use or apply Windows 10, version 1803 on either GR or remote node.
- Workaround 2 Roll back to a version previous to Windows 10, version 1803. Refer to Microsoft for instructions on rolling back or uninstalling Windows 10, version 1803.
- Workaround 3 Uncheck the Enable storage to historian option under each AppEngine as follows:
 - 1. Logon to the IDE.
 - 2. Open the target deployment platform, GR or the remote.
 - 3. Navigate to the engine page on the General tab.




Figure 2: Uncheck Enable storage to historian.

 - 4. Make sure the option Enable storage to historian is not checked (Figure 2 below).

NOTE: For Workaround 3, AppEngines running on this platform are no longer configured to send attribute alarms and history data to the Historian. To configuring alarm data, refer to **Configuring Alarming for System Objects** in the IDE.pdf guide.
